Book Rental Scheme 2021-2022 Terms of Agreement

- The scheme is open to all classes from Junior Infants to Sixth Class. New members will not be permitted to join after 2nd class.
- Once parents sign up to the Book Rental scheme – they will also be included in workbook package, where workbooks are supplied at a discounted price.
- Parents will pay a fee of €20 per child per annum for 1st to 6th class and €10 per child per annum for Junior and Senior Infants.
- A security deposit will be payable for each child. The security deposit will be €30 on entering the scheme.
- This security deposit is payable only once to be returned once the child leaves the scheme (generally at the end of 6th class). The security deposit will be held against the safe return of all books rented to pupils under the scheme. If books are lost or damaged, the parent will be responsible for replacing the book. The decision of the book rental committee is final in the determination of the condition of rental books on their return to the school.
- Once children receive the books, they will be used in the normal way throughout the year, bringing them home when needed etc. They will be parent's responsibility until they are returned at the end of the school year.
- The books must be kept in good order; highlighters are not to be used and notes not be written into books. The ongoing wear and tear of books will be taken into account.
- Books supplied under the book rental scheme may be new or second-hand
- The fees must be paid by the specified date. It is understood that if a parent does pay the fees by the specified date, they do not wish to enter the book rental scheme and will be responsible for purchasing their own books.

The rental books will be covered, labelled and ready in the classroom on the return to school in September.

- A list of class names will be shared with the Book Rental Committee for administration purposes. No other personal information will be shared. Please contact the school if there are any concerns in this regard.
